NDCC CODE OF ETHICS FOR JUNIORS

This Code of ethics outlines basic procedures and sets forth principles of general conduct to be followed by all members. Failure to do so shall result in disciplinary action as set out in the Constitution/By laws of the Newfoundland Dog Club of Canada. These responsibilities apply equally to junior and adult members of the NDCC.

Responsibilities of Members

- 1. All members (junior or adult) shall abide by the Constitution/By-laws of the NDCC and the rules of the CKC.
- 2. Members are encouraged to support the efforts of the NDCC regarding health issues of the Newfoundland and are encouraged to participate in testing, surveys and seminars, which would help to educate them further.
- 3. Members shall ensure that their Newfoundlands are at all times treated in a humane and caring manner, including adequate food, water, shelter, grooming, companionship and veterinary care.
- 4. Members are encouraged to undertake appropriate training to ensure that their Newfoundland will be a welcome member of the community.
- 5. Members shall conduct themselves in an appropriate manner and exhibit good sportsmanship when participating in any activity, which involve the Newfoundland or the NDCC.

Sportsmanship behaviour includes:

- a) always considering the welfare of their dog(s) first before everything else;
- b) committing themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace;
- c) competing vigorously and civilly and appreciating the merit of their competition and the effort of other competitors;
- d) maintaining full and adequate control of their dog(s) and being mindful of their responsibility to handle them appropriately;
- e) accepting constructive criticism;
- f) welcoming, encouraging and supporting newcomers to the sport and the Newfoundland breed;
- g) respecting the NDCC constitution and it's by laws;
- h) refusing to embarrass the NDCC, the sport of purebred dog showing or themselves while taking part in the sport;
- i) presenting themselves and their dogs in an appropriate, clean and well groomed fashion;
- j) taking every opportunity to further their knowledge and education on Newfoundland dogs, their history, their conformation, their working abilities and their many talents;
- k) being an ambassador for the Newfoundland dog breed whenever possible.
- 6. Members shall refrain from knowingly making untrue statements about the stock or practices of themselves or others involved in the showing and /or breeding of Newfoundland dogs.
